9:00 am Discovery Hour

Nursery (Ages 1 - 3)

Meets in Nursery upstairs. Structured play, Bible lesson, and crafts.

Discovery Hour Kids (Ages 4 - 4th grade)

Meets underwater (downstairs) in The Coral Reef. Songs, Bible story, activities.

Discovery Hour Youth (5th - 8th grade)

Meets underwater (downstairs) in The Shipwreck. Interactive Bible lesson.

10:30 am Main Service

Nursery (Ages 6mo. - 24mo.)

Meets in The Nursery upstairs. Structured play and personal care.

Skippers (Age 2 - 3)

Meets underwater (downstairs) in The Marina. Play, Bible lesson, snacks, crafts.

Pilots (Age 4 - Kindergarten)

Meets underwater (downstairs) in The Coral Reef. Bible lesson, activity, snacks, crafts.

Navigators (1st - 3rd grade)

Meets underwater (downstairs) in The Shipwreck. Bible lesson, activity, snacks, crafts.

Vision

We desire to come alongside you, the parents, to raise a generation of godly children who know, love, and serve Jesus. At FBC, we value your children as much as you do. That's why each Sunday and Wednesday (Awana), we teach your children from God's Word, and do so in an environment that is safe, clean, and secure.

Gospel-Centered

Sunday classes utilize The Gospel Project curriculum. Kids are taught chronologically through the Bible over 3 years, highlighting key doctrines and pointing them to Jesus every week. Each class focuses on the same verses and key points so your whole family is unified in what they learn!

Safe

Child-to-volunteer ratios are monitored to ensure proper attention is given. Each room is equipped with First Aid Kits and lockdown mechanisms. All volunteers have passed background checks, been interviewed by leadership, and attended FBC for at least 6 months (or have a letter of good standing from former church). All attend annual training on safety, sexual abuse prevention, restroom procedures, emergency protocol, and more.

Clean

Rooms are cleaned weekly. Toys are age appropriate and sanitized after every class. Gluten-free snacks are available upon request.

Secure

The sticker check-in system ensures appropriate child pick up and allergy identification. Security personnel are stationed in the Foyer at all times. Upon dismissing kids from service, all exterior building doors are locked to protect from unwanted entries.

In the event of an evacuation, kids will be taken as a class to the south parking lot (gravel lot). Please do NOT take your kids until Leader has verified all are accounted for at the parking lot. Fire drills are conducted annually so kids and volunteers are prepared.
